



Cover: The Wnt receptor Fzd7 is essential for stem cell function in the intestine but its function in the stomach is unknown. Fzd7 is expressed in the antrum of the gastric epithelium, which can be used to culture organoids (top). After genetic deletion of *Fzd7*, such organoids cannot survive beyond 72 hours (bottom). This is also true *in vivo*, with deletion of *Fzd7* resulting in rapid repopulation of the gastric epithelium in mice; thus demonstrating that Wnt signalling, via Fzd7, is crucial for gastric homeostasis.
